Coton Manor is a 10 acre garden that was voted 'The Nation's Favourite Garden in 2019'. A very well cared for garden with lots of colourful planting, in June as well as a rose garden, expect to see achilleas, delphiniums, clematis, thalictrums, salvias, foxgloves & many more. The Stableyard Cafe serves light lunches until 14.30 but teas, cakes & scones are available all afternoon. Please note that picnics are not allowed in the garden but if anyone wants to take their own food it can be eaten in the grassed car park. There is a well stocked plant nursery for anyone wanting a 'special plant' most of which are plants that have been propagated from the garden.
